Commandment

(εντολη)

In the KJV, it is used as "commandment," "commandments," and "precept." Newer versions also use words like "orders" and "commands." The word is used 71 times, 32 of which refer directly to the Law of Moses. They include references to the Ten Commandments, "Love your neighbor," and "the commandments of the priests." These are:

Matthew 5:19, 15:3, 15:6, 19:17, 22:36, 22:38, 22:40

Mark 7:8, 7:9, 10:5, 10:19, 12:28 (twice), 12:30, 12:31 (twice)

Luke 1:6, 18:20, 23:56

Ephesians 2:15, 6:2

Hebrews 7:5, 7:16, 7:18, 9:19

The word is used a few times in a non-religious context:

Luke 15:29	The prodigal son's brother obeyed the commandments of his father.
John 11:57	The chief priest gave commandments that anyone knowing of Jesus
	whereabouts should report it.
Acts 17:15	Paul gave commandments that Timothy and Silas join him in Athens.
Colossians 4:10	Paul had given commandments to the Colossians concerning Timothy's
	welcome.

Jesus received commandments from the Father:

John 10:18	I have authority to lay it [My life] down and I have authority to take it up. This
	commandment I received from My Father.
John 12:49-50	I did not speak on My own initiative, but the Father who sent me has given Me
	commandment, what to say and what to speak. And I know that His
	commandment is eternal life; therefore the things I speak, I speak just as the
	Father has told Me.

Jesus gave commandments while on earth:

The religious connotation of the word is used to strengthen sarcasm.

Several passages encourage Christians to follow religious commandments in general.

1 Corinthians 7:19 Circumcision is nothing and uncircumcision is nothing, but what matters is the keeping of the commandments of God.

Keep the commandment without stain or reproach until the appearing of our 1 Timothy 6:14 Lord Jesus Christ. 1 John 5:2-3 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and observe His commandments. For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments, and His commandments are not burdensome. 2 John 4-6 I was very glad to find some of your children walking in truth, just as we have received commandment to do from the Father. And now I ask you, lady, not as writing to you a new commandment, but the one which we have had from the beginning, that we love one another. And this is love, that we walk according to His commandments. This is the commandment, just as you have heard from the beginning, that you should walk in it. Revelation 12:17 And the dragon was enraged with the woman and went off to make war with the rest of her offspring who keep the commandments of God and hold to the testimony of Jesus.
