In the NASB and NIV, nine different Greek words are translated as some form of the word, "devotion." In the KJV New Testament, these words are not used. Modern translators used "devotion" because the meaning in that place matched at least some facet of the modern meaning.

Modern translators were of the opinion that all of these facets were incorporated into our word, "devotion," and that there was no confusion of meaning by using the same word in place of nine different Greek words. Rather, the implications of all nine were assumed be reasonably tied together.
