2 Corinthians 4:6

“...to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ.”

What is the glory of God we are to shine forth?

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- Genesis 31:1 Laban’s sons were concerned that Jacob’s success had taken Laban’s glory.
- Genesis 45:13 Joseph spoke of his glory in Egypt.
- Exodus 16::6 – 12 The glory of God appeared in a cloud.
- Exodus 24:12 – 18 The glory of God rested on Mount Sinai and Moses entered it.

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- Exodus 28:2, 40 Priestly garments for glory and beauty
- Exodus 29:43, 40:34 – 38, 1 Kings 8:11, 2 Chronicles 5:14, Ezekiel 10:4 Tabernacle/temple consecrated by God’s glory
- Exodus 33:18 – 34:9 Show me Thy glory
- Leviticus 9:6 – 23, 2 Chronicles 7:1 – 3 God’s glory appeared at the first sacrifice at the tabernacle/temple

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- Numbers 14:10 The glory of God appeared to rescue Joshua and Caleb from the people
- Numbers 14:21 – 22 A promise: all the world will be filled with the glory of God
- Numbers 16:19, 42, 20:6 The glory of God rescued Moses and Aaron from rebellions
- Deuteronomy 5:24 Review of Exodus 16
- Joshua 7:19, 1 Samuel 6:5, Jeremiah 13:16 Give glory to God

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- 1 Samuel 2:8 – 9 The godly inherit a throne of glory
- 1 Samuel 4:21 – 22 The glory of God was associated with the ark of the covenant
- 2 Kings 14:10 A king gloried in his triumph
- 2 Kings 16:24 – 35, Psalm 96:3, 97:6 Tell of His glory among the nations
- Esther 5:11 Haman recounted his own glory
- Job 19:9, 29:20 God stripped Job’s glory

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- Psalm 3:3 The Lord is my glory
- Psalm 4:2 How long will my glory be a reproach?
- Psalm 8:5 (Hebrews 2:7) The Messiah to be crowned with glory and honor
- Psalm 16:9 My glory rejoices
- Psalm 19:1 The heavens declare the glory of God

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- Psalm 21:5 (The king's) glory is great through Thy salvation
- Psalm 24:7 – 10 The Lord of glory
- Psalm 29:1 – 9 In His temple, everything says, "Glory."
- Psalm 30:12 That my glory may sing praise to Thee.
- Psalm 49:16 – 17 Man's glory does not endure

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- Psalm 57:5 – 11 God's glory above all the earth; awake, my glory!
- Psalm 62:7 On God my glory and salvation rest
- Psalm 63:2 To see Thy power and Thy glory
- Psalm 72:19 May the whole earth be filled with His glory
- Psalm 73:24 And afterward, receive me to glory
- Psalm 79:9 Help us...for the glory of Thy name

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- Psalm 84:11 God will give grace and glory
- Psalm 85:9 His salvation is near to those who fear Him, that glory may dwell in our land
- Psalm 96:7 – 8 Ascribe to the Lord glory
- Psalm 102:15 – 16 All the nations will fear...Thy glory
- Psalm 104:31 The glory of the Lord shall endure forever

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- Psalm 106:20 They exchanged their glory for an image
- Psalm 108:1 – 5 I will sing praises with my glory
- Psalm 113:4 His glory is above the heavens
- Psalm 138:5 Great is the glory of the Lord
- Psalm 145:11 They shall speak of the glory of Thy kingdom

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- Psalm 149:5 Let the saints exult in glory
- Proverbs 25:2 It is the glory of God to conceal a matter; the glory of kings to search out
- Proverbs 25:27 It is not good to eat much honey, nor is it glory to seek one's own glory
- Isaiah 6:3 The whole earth is full of His glory
- Isaiah 40:5 The glory of the Lord will be revealed

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- Isaiah 43:7 Everyone who is called by my name, whom I have created for My glory
- Ezekiel 1:28, 3:23, 8:4 Rainbow – like the glory of God
- Ezekiel 39:21 Glory of God in His judgments
- Habakkuk 2:14 The earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- Matthew 16:27, 24:30, 25:31, Mark 8:38, 13:26, Luke 9:26, 21:27 The Son of Man is going to come in the glory of His Father
- Luke 2:9 – 14 The glory of the Lord shone around them
- Luke 9:31 Moses and Elijah appeared in glory
- Luke 17:18 Give glory to God
- Luke 24:26 Christ to suffer these things and to enter into His glory

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- John 1:14 We beheld His glory
- John 2:11 Beginning of His signs...manifested His glory
- John 11:4, 40 Lazarus death and resurrection was to display the glory of God
- John 17:5 Jesus had glory before coming here
- John 17:22 Jesus passed His glory to disciples
- Acts 7:55 Stephen saw the glory of God
- Romans 1:23 Exchanged the glory of God for..

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- Romans 3:23 All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God
- Romans 4:20 Abraham believed the promise of a son and gave glory to God
- Romans 6:4 Raised by the glory of the Father
- Romans 8:18 The glory that is to be revealed
- Romans 9:23 The riches of His glory upon vessels of mercy
- Romans 15:7 Accepted us to the glory of God

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- 1 Corinthians 10:31 Do all to the glory of God
- 2 Corinthians 3:18 Transformed into the same image from glory to glory
- Ephesians 3:13 My tribulations are your glory
- 1 Thessalonians 2:12 Walk in a manner worthy ...calls you into His own kingdom and glory
- 1 Thessalonians 2:20 You are our glory and joy
- Hebrews 1:3 The radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature

Glory

The word is used in several ways.

- 1 Peter 5:10 Called you into His eternal glory
- 2 Peter 1:3 Called us by His own glory
- Revelation 21:23 The glory of God did light it

Glory

What is the glory of God we are to shine forth?

- The glory of God is His character: compassion, grace, patience, lovingkindness, faithfulness, forgiveness, justice, and power.
- Giving glory to God is recounting these perfect qualities.
- Displaying these qualities is impossible for humans
- We display that which is miraculously given
