Heaven

- The Scriptures contain very few descriptions of heaven.
 - God is in heaven (Ecclesiastes 5:2)
 - "The God of heaven" appears many times.
 - God sits on His throne in Heaven (Psalm 11:4)
 - God sees people from heaven (Psalm 33:13, 53:2, 102:19)
 - God is spirit (John 4:24)
 - Longest description: Revelation 4

Heaven

- Many popular descriptions of heaven actually are about the "new heaven" that will appear after the present creation is destroyed.
 - Revelation 21:1 22:5
 - Hebrews 12:26 from Haggai 2:6
 - Isaiah 65:17, 66:22 24
 - 1 Corinthians 15:35 58
 - 2 Peter 3:7 13

Explaining Heaven

- How can we explain the place where God lives to those who think only concretely, not abstractly?
 - Are fantasies bad?
 - How do we make the transition from fantasy to reality?
 - Tell what you know, then ask a child to tell what he or she thinks about it.

Heaven in History

- Satan and his angels formerly had free access (Job 1:6 12, 21:1 8, Zechariah 3:1 2, Revelation 12:9 10).
- After Jesus returned to heaven, Satan was exiled from heaven to earth (Revelation 12:7 17).
- Jesus cleansed the original tabernacle with His blood and completed His sacrifice (Hebrews 9:11 – 12).

Inhabitants of Heaven

- Not all inhabitants of heaven have stayed (the devil and his angels).
- Not all those who wish to enter will be allowed (Matthew 25:32 46).
- The spirits of the faithful are in heaven now (Ephesians 2:6, Revelation 6:9 – 11, 7:9 – 17, 14:1 – 5).

Inhabitants of Heaven

• When creation is released from decay, the physically dead faithful will return with Jesus to collect the physically alive faithful (1 Thessalonians 4:13 – 18) and all will receive a new body of a different type (1 Corinthians 15:35 – 58).

Inhabitants of Heaven

- Are our characters changed only on resurrection day or before?
 - 2 Corinthians 3:18
 - Colossians 3:9 10
 - Ephesians 4:22 24
 - Romans 8:13 14
 - 2 Peter 1:4
 - 1 John 5:4
- Will those in the final heaven have the ability to make choices?

Inhabitants of Heaven

- Although no person or spirit or temptation or experience is strong enough to force us away from faith (John 10:29, 1 John 4:4, 1 Corinthians 10:13, Romans 8:38 39 *et al*), we have the ability to choose to reject faith (Galatians 5:4, Hebrews 3:12, 6:4 6, Romans 11:20 23, Revelation 3:5, *et al*).
- Will people without faith be in the final heaven?

Inhabitants of Heaven

- Do we know that we will not choose unbelief in the future? How can we have security? How can we know that we have eternal life (1 John 5:13)?
 - Jude 24 25 God is able
 - 1 John 4:13 When we see the work of the Spirit in us.
 - 2 Corinthians 4:7
 - 1 Peter 4:10 11
