

**Those who are “in” Christ  
(Ephesians 1:18 – 2:10)**

- Have eternal life (John 3:15, Romans 6:23, 1 Thessalonians 4:16, 1 John 5:11)
- Are alive to God (Romans 6:11)
- Receive no condemnation (Romans 8:1)
- Are one body (Romans 12:5)
- Have the veil removed (2 Corinthians 3:14)
- Are strong (Ephesians 6:10)

**Those who are “in” Christ:**

- Are new creatures (2 Corinthians 5:17)
- Have redemption (Ephesians 1:7)
- Were brought near to God (Ephesians 2:13)
- Are completed (Colossians 1:28, 2:6 – 10)
- Have salvation (2 Timothy 2:10)
- Are sealed (Ephesians 1:13)
- Can be immature (1 Corinthians 3:1)
- Are blessed (Ephesians 1:3)

**Passing “into” Christ involves:**

- His doing (Ephesians 3:10)
- Believing (Ephesians 1:13)
- Being baptized (Romans 6:3, Galatians 3:27)
- Growing up (Ephesians 4:14-15)
- Walking as He walked (1 John 2:5 – 6)
- A new self (Ephesians 4:24, Colossians 3:10 – 17, Romans 13:14)

**The clothing image**

- Sometimes refers to the time after Judgment (1 Corinthians 15:53, 2 Corinthians 5:2 – 5)
- Putting on the armor of light = putting on Christ (Romans 13:12 – 14)
- The full armor of God is in the Lord (Ephesians 6:10 – 13)

**Where is Christ in whom we are?**

- In the heavenly places (Ephesians 1:20, 2:6)

**Spiritual Life, Death, and  
Resurrection**

- Our spirits were created in the image of God. (Genesis 1:26 – 27, 9:6, 1 Corinthians 11:7)
- When we sinned, our spirits died. We were walking tombs. (Genesis 3:3, Romans 7:9)
- When we were baptized, our spirits were resurrected. (Colossians 2:12 – 13, Romans 8:29, 2 Corinthians 3:18, Colossians 3:10)

**Spiritual Life, Death, and  
Resurrection**

- Our resurrected spirits are with Jesus in heaven. (Ephesians 1:20, 2:6)
- The Holy Spirit dwells in our empty tombs, helping to coordinate our control of this earthly body from our seat in Christ in the heavenly places. (Romans 8:9 – 17)
- Unbelievers are the tombs of dead spirits with no control mechanism. (Romans 7:14 – 24)
